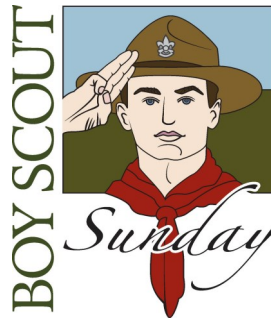

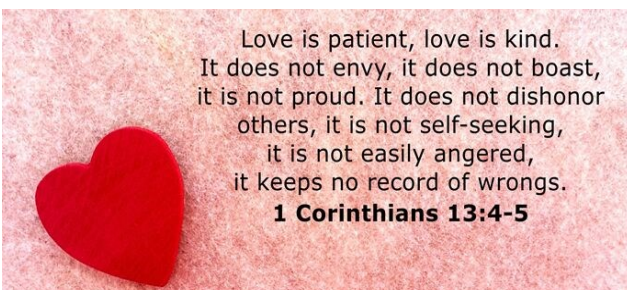

Valentine's Day!*



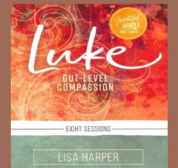

Deposits for Summer Camps Due February 4

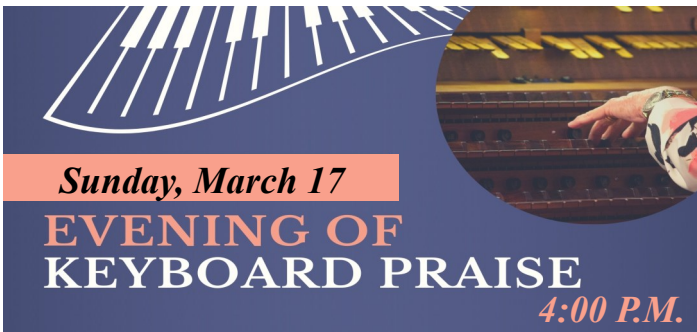
Both our children and youth will head to CentriKid or MFuge camps this summer during the same week (Monday-Friday, June 10-14) and at the same location (Ridgecrest Conference Center)! The cost for each camp is \$300 per student, but we plan to offer several fundraisers to help lower the cost. Each camp requires a \$50 non-refundable deposit, which must be paid **no later than Sunday, February 4**. Parents, pay Laura White for CentriKid, or pay Connor Bastin for MFUGE. All remaining unfilled slots will be released after February 4.
