Words from Our Pastor

If you've ever played high school football, or known someone who has, you're probably familiar with the infamous two-a-day practices. In the sweltering heat of summer, players push through grueling morning and afternoon sessions, run drills, study plays, and battle fatigue. It's tough, sweaty, and often miserable. And yet, every athlete knows this is where the foundation is laid.

Our faith isn't all that different. In our spiritual lives, we often long for mountain-top experiences—those moments when God feels close, prayers are answered, and everything is clear. But more often than not, growth happens in the trenches. It occurs in the routine and repetition. It happens when we show up again, even when we don't feel like it.

Two-a-days were never glamorous. There were no crowds or cheers, just commitment and sweat. In the same way, persistence in our faith often means showing up in quiet moments, reading Scripture when our hearts feel dry, praying when answers don't come quickly, and serving others when we're running on empty. And just like those summer practices prepared us for Friday night lights, our persistence in faith prepares us for what God has in store for our future. Paul reminds us in Galatians 6:9, "Let us not grow weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."

God sees the work we put in when no one else does. He honors faithfulness, even when it feels unseen. And just like a coach who knows the season ahead and pushes his players to be ready, our Heavenly Father is preparing us for what's coming. He's strengthening our character, growing our endurance, and teaching us to trust, not just in the easy moments, but especially in the hard ones.

So if you're in a season where faith feels like work, if you feel like you have been fighting through sweltering two-a-day practices and you are tired—don't lose heart. Keep showing up. Keep pressing on. God is at work, even if you can't see it yet. The cool breeze and fall harvest are just around the corner.


