Conversations: A Simple Approach to Sharing the Gospel Saturday, July 26 9:00 A.M. - 12:00 P.M.


We are all called to share the gospel, but few of us do so regularly. Perhaps you have a desire to share, but feel ill-prepared or simply fear what response you might receive.

Words from Our Pastor

As we approach Independence Day, we're reminded of the great blessings we enjoy as Americans—freedom of speech, freedom to gather, and most importantly, freedom to worship our Lord without fear. These are privileges we should never take for granted. We thank God for the men and women who have sacrificed to secure them.

But as believers, we also know a deeper, eternal freedom, a freedom that only Christ can give. In the New Testament, Paul writes a short letter to Philemon about a slave named Onesimus. who fled from Philemon's home to seek freedom in Rome. He did indeed find freedom, but not the kind he expected.

Through Paul's ministry, Onesimus encountered Christ. Once transformed, he decided to return to Philemon. In Paul pleads that Philemon receive him, "*no longer as a bondservant but more than a bondservant, as a beloved brother*..." (Philemon 1:16). The belief is that Onesimus not only gained his spiritual freedom, but that Philemon granted him personal freedom. It is believed that Onesimus eventually became the Bishop of Ephesus.

This powerful truth speaks directly to our hearts today. Just as Onesimus found true freedom in Christ, so do we. While we may enjoy freedom as citizens of this great nation, our highest freedom is found in Jesus freedom from sin, from guilt, and from spiritual death.

Our nation's freedom is a gift, but it is Christ who truly sets us free. Galatians 5:1 instructs us to remember that freedom and to walk in it: *"For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery"* (Galatians 5:1). This freedom then is not without responsibility. We are called to remain in it, and we are further called to serve in light of it: *"For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another"* (Galatians 5:13).

We serve each other by living in community, by forgiving one another, by encouraging each other, by challenging, and by sharing with one another and sometimes even correcting each other.

This July 4th, let's celebrate our country's freedom with gratitude. Even more, let's rejoice in the freedom

we have in Jesus. Let's share that Good News with a world still in need of it.
