

### Palm Sunday, March 24

On this Sunday before Easter, we will celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem with children entering the Sanctuary waving palm branches and Rev. Laura White delivering the sermon. Special music will be provided by the Clarion Sounds.

#### Maundy Thursday, March 28 6:30 P.M.

*Worship with us during the Service of Shadows, an observance* that has been practiced in churches for centuries. Candles, lit at the beginning of the service, are extinguished at points indicated in scriptural readings and musical selections that tell the story of the events leading up to Jesus' trial, crucifixion, and burial. The extinguished candles symbolize the world growing darker at each point in the story. Following the Observance of The Lord's Supper, everyone will leave the service in silence, contemplating in our hearts the ultimate Gift of sacrifice on the cross.
