Senior Pastor Search Committee Schedule

As we continue our Season of Prayer for our Senior Pastor Search Committee during the month of December, the Deacons and Staff want to provide information about the schedule for moving forward.

Sunday, January 21 Search Team Committee Election

You will nominate five individuals whom you feel would prayerfully assume the responsibility of serving on the Search Committee.
You must be present to cast your vote.

The five members who receive the most nominations will be asked to serve alongside the Deacon Chair. The group will determine the process they will follow to fill the position and bring this process to the congregation for a vote. The committee will also determine the qualifications and create a job description for the next Senior Pastor. Notifications of the position will be submitted to the Southern Baptist Convention, the South Carolina Baptist Convention, the Spartanburg County Baptist Network, and the *Baptist Courier*. Resumes will then be received.

Please see below Article V, Section 2 of our Church By-laws:

If the vacancy is the Senior Pastor position, the congregation will nominate individuals to form a search committee. The top five candidates who agree to serve will form the Senior Pastor Search Committee, along with the Deacon Chair. The Senior Pastor Search Committee will recommend a process to fill the vacancy. The church will vote on the recommended process.
