Holy Week

Holy Week commemorates the days from Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem (Palm Sunday) through His final evening with the disciples —The Last Supper...the garden... the betrayal (Maundy Thursday)—through the events of His trial and crucifixion (Good Friday), and culminating with a glorious celebration of His resurrection (Easter Sunday or Resurrection Sunday). We invite you to join us for all of our Holy Week Services at Morningside.

Palm Sunday (Sunday of the Passion), April 2 9:30 A.M. Witness the Procession of Palms by the children of Morningside, music to praise and honor our Lord, and a message from our Pastor from the sermon series Why Do I Need a Sacrifice?

Maundy Thursday, April 6 6:30 P.M.

Worship with us during the Service of Shadows (Tenebrae in Latin), an observance that has been practiced in churches for centuries on any of the last three days of Holy Week. Candles, lit at the beginning of the service, are extinguished at points indicated in scriptural readings and musical selections that tell the story of the events leading up to Jesus' trial, crucifixion, and burial. The extinguished candles symbolize the world growing darker at each point in the story. This service depicts Jesus' ultimate sacrifice. Following the Observance of The Lord's Supper, everyone will leave the service in silence, contemplating in our hearts the ultimate Gift of sacrifice on the cross.

Good Friday, April 7 11:00 A.M. – 1:00 P.M.

Morningside is hosting a Good Friday Outreach Event for our members and surrounding community, which will feature lunch of a hotdog, chips, and drink on our front lawn where children can jump on inflatables. Please join us for this time of fellowship and outreach to our community.

Easter Sunday, April 9 9:00 A.M.

We will gather at the front entrance of our Sanctuary for a "Son Rise" Celebration. Following a brief devotional and music, we will place flowers on the cross on the front lawn, symbolizing how our Lord's resurrection now brings life out of death. We will continue our celebration at 9:30 A.M. with triumphant music, the Ordinance of Baptism, and an Easter message.
